Dear Parents and Caregivers,

During the first three of weeks of this term there has been a noticeable increase in the number of children either arriving late or leaving early. Whilst there are times where this may be necessary, it is important that these interruptions are kept to a minimum. Regular and continuous attendance at school is essential for all children to maintain continuity with their learning and assist with sustained progress.

The school day begins with certain routines and activities e.g. prayer, roll call etc. so it is essential that children arrive at school by **8.55am**. The school grounds are open to pupils from 8.35am each morning and remain open to pupils until 3.35pm each afternoon. Children are not supervised prior to 8.35am each morning and after 3.35pm. Parents are requested not to bring children prior to 8.35am or pick them up after 3.35pm.

We start each day with a morning assembly to ensure that all students are greeted and that any important information is shared. It is important that all children are on the assembly with their class and not waiting at the classroom door to meet the teacher. If any parent needs to share information with their child's homeroom teacher this should done before the morning assembly. Alternatively, if the matter requires more than a quick chat, all staff are more than happy to make an appointment to discuss matters in detail.

Once the assembly has started, all teaching staff have taken responsibility for the care and learning of the children and need to be fully focused on this very important task. Parents who are not acting to assist with exchanging readers or other tasks are asked not to enter the classroom during teaching and learning time. I thank all parents for your assistance with these matters.

Last night I had the pleasure of accompanying our student leaders to a civic reception held at the Evan Theatre at Panthers Penrith. The reception was sponsored by the Penrith City Council to recognise the role of students who have been selected by their peers as being leaders within their communities. Congratulations to our school leaders for the way that you conducted yourselves on Wednesday evening and for the way that you represent Holy Family School in carrying out your responsibilities.

In partnership let us continue to work to develop in the children strong minds and gentle hearts.

### Working With Children Check for Volunteers

We always encourage and are grateful for the presence and support of parents at all of our community-based activities. These include reading helpers, excursions, sporting and cultural events as well as celebration gatherings like Grandparents Day, Mothers Day etc. In recent years NSW Government legislation has changed and now requires that all volunteers are required to



have a current Working With Children Check. This check replaces the previous online modules from the Parramatta Catholic Education Office, that many parents completed in the past.

The Working With Children Check is now required for any parents, grandparents etc who volunteer to assist at school based activities. For the purpose of the Working With Children Check a volunteer is someone 18yrs or older and who does not receive payment for their work.

To apply for a Working With Children Check, you must first fill in an online application form, and then present proof of your identity at a NSW Motor Registry, RMS agency, or Service NSW office.

- Go to www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/check and complete the online application form. If you do not have access to the internet, please telephone (02) 9286 7219 for assistance.
- Go to a NSW Motor Registry, RMS agency, or Service NSW office (not your local Council). Find a location at www.service.nsw.gov.au/service-centre.
- You will need your application number and proof of your identity. You must have both of these items for your application to proceed.

It is important to note that there is no cost involved to volunteers in applying for the Working With Children Check.
