Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Thank you for your continued understanding in relation to the ongoing management of the COVID 19 virus. As you would understand, as a school we have a social responsibility to take continued action to avoid the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in our community.

Coronavirus presents an extraordinary challenge for education institutions globally. At Holy Family, we are trying to respond in ways that prioritise both the health and safety of students, staff and families, and to protect the learning for our students.

As stated previously in my communications to you, we are following the advice provided by NSW Health and by Catholic Schools NSW. We are in constant communication with Catholic Education - Diocese of Parramatta for advice and procedural matters.


Kids Yoga with Little Lotus Studio
