Ongoing Measures

Safety and Hygiene

- Students and staff must not attend school if they are unwell
- Each student or staff member who is absent or who has been sent home from school, due to flu like symptoms must be tested
- Students or staff members must not return to school or work until they return a negative COVID-19 results
 and are symptom free. Schools must sight the negative COVID-19 test result prior to allowing students and
 staff to return to school i.e. NSW Health or COVID-19 Testing Centre correspondence (SMS, email or hard
 copy) and/or a medical certificate must be provided to the school

School Operations

- Students to stay within their relevant stage group for all activities, wherever possible
- Schools must not travel outside of their local community area or zone for all inter-school activities, including sport
- Only approved external providers that support the delivery of the curriculum may continue

School Related Activities

- Group activities such as choirs, chanting and the use of wind instruments in a group setting are not permitted
- Whole school community events or functions are still not permitted
- The preference for parent/carer meetings with staff is for online (e.g. Zoom) or via telephone

NSW Health continues to advise schools to:

- Ensure good hand hygiene at all times for students and staff (e.g. entry to the classroom and upon exit of the classroom)
- All adults must maintain physical distance from each other (1.5m) including teachers and support staff, and parents/carers. Schools should ensure school pick up and drop off arrangements enable parents/carers to physically distance from one another and from staff (see details below). This will continue throughout Term 4.

Morning Drop Off Procedures

- Kiss 'n' Drop will be in operation between 8:35 and 9:00am.
- Parents/carers wishing to walk their child to the school gate need to park and accompany their child to the front gate. No parents/carers are to enter the school grounds
- Playground supervision will be provided from 8:35am

Afternoon Pick Up Procedures

- Students attending after school care or catching a bus will gather in the hall
- Parents/carers picking up students are to line up along the path outside the church and observe the social distancing markers on the path. Students will be called by a staff member to meet the parent/carer and then exit via the path outside the office. Please do not ask to pick up other students at this point unless the office has been notified by the other parent prior to 2:30pm, giving sufficient time to notify the teachers on duty
- Students can be picked up between **3:10** -**3:35pm**. After 3:35pm children will wait in the office
- We respectfully ask that parents/carers pick up their child/ren and move off the site as quickly as possible. Please do not gather in the carpark.

Complaint Handling Procedures - Reminder for Families

If, at any time, you find that you have a concern with the school, you are encouraged to come to the school and speak with the teachers, assistant principal and/or principal, to find a resolution for your concern.

It is our aim to work with all members of our school community to ensure that we do the very best we can to provide a productive, safe and enjoyable learning experience for our students and professionally fulfilling experience for our staff.

If you would like to raise a concern formally, the Catholic Education Office has procedures for ensuring that complaints are handled fairly. 
