## Carpark AND Drop Off/Pickup Points

The following times have been declared as peak times for the traffic flow for our school:-8.30a.m. to 9.00a.m. 3.00p.m. to 3.30p.m.

The following procedures have been put in place for the safety of your children. Please adhere to these expectations:

- The carpark is marked with arrows allowing cars to enter and drive through one way only. This must be adhered to as a safety precaution.
- School Drop-off Pick-up ZONE
- <u>Vehicles must park in a marked car space</u> (especially when dropping off or picking up a student) and only cars with disabled parking permits should park in the spaces designated for this purpose.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult when walking through the carpark
- Kiss'n'Drop is available from 8:30-9:00am each day.
- Kiss'n'Ride is available from 3:00pm. Please adhere to the staggered pick up arrangements:
- From 3:00pm Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 students
- From 3:15pm Stage 2 and Stage 3 students (and siblings from Early Stage 1 and Stage 1)
- The staggered pick up arrangements are in place to reduce congestion around the school at 3pm. This will ensure the safety of our families and minimise the impact on traffic in Willowdene Avenue.

- Assessing ones strengths and limitations


The students have found these lessons to be extremely valuable and important for their emotional learning.
